1st Reading YMCA Beavers & Cubs had a joint meeting at which Sarah, from Feathers and Fur Falconry Centre brought some of her British birds of prey.

The Beavers and Cubs learnt the importance of wearing a leather glove before handling the birds and were shown how to stand to hold them. The children met a barn owl and a kestrel which they were allowed to handle.



Sarah then allowed the leaders and helpers to handle a European eagle owl and harris hawk which were much bigger and heavier than the barn owl and kestrel. The meeting ended with the finale; the Harris Hawk flew low and fast right over the Beavers and Cubs, who had been asked to lie in a row the length of the Linear Hall, landing on my glove.
