## Water Pump

Many of you may recognise, from the photo, the 19<sup>th</sup> century water pump which was rehoused to the Sensory Garden in Linear Park when the A4

was widened in 2014. What you may not know, is that Holybrook Parish Council is working closely with the Heritage Forum to get our pump listed locally as a heritage asset. Our pump has several interesting elements including its original (now not working) internal mechanisms, signs of the amount of usage in the worn area behind the partial handle and an original pin holding the handle in place. Unfortunately, the original cap is missing but, all in all, our pump is considered to be in good condition.

### **Catalytic Converter Theft**

Did you know a thief can take the catalytic converter from your car in a matter of minutes and leave you to foot the bill?

**POLICF** 

A catalytic converter is a device that helps to cut harmful emissions produced by your car. The device is made of precious metals that thieves often target in exchange for money at a scrap yard.

You can protect your vehicle by:

• Where possible, parking in a protected garage, or park in a location that restricts access to underneath your vehicle

• Consider security lighting and the installation of CCTV

• Mark your catalytic converter with a forensic marker and register your converter to make it harder for thieves to dispose of

• Speak to a mechanic to find out other ways you can protect your vehicle

Report any suspicious behaviour to the Police online or by calling 101 or 999 in an emergency.
